Cost of Living

Depending on the university location, area of study and personal needs, the estimated cost is around CHF 1,850 a month.

Accommodation

Finding accommodation can be difficult depending on the place you want to stay. International students are advised to look for accommodation in good time.


Health Insurance

Basic insurance coverage is compulsory for all persons living for more than three months in Switzerland. International students may be exempt in specific cases.

Entry, Visa & Residence Permits

Students from EU/EFTA countries must register with the competent cantonal authority and apply for a residence permit within 14 days of arrival in Switzerland. Students from non-EU/EFTA countries must apply for a visa prior to entering Switzerland. The visa application process takes at least eight weeks.

Public universities have moderate tuition fees: mostly between CHF 500 and CHF 2,000 per semester.




International students may work a maximum of 15 hours per week during their studies, and up to 100 per cent during semester breaks.




